Please refer to the Bidding Documents for lease of Berinmadhoo and Hathifushi in Haa Alifu Atoll for development as Tourist Resorts.

This is to inform you that pursuant to Clause 23.1 of the Instructions to Bidders (ITB), bidding for the Island of Hathifushi in Haa Alifu Atoll is hereby annulled by the Ministry. However, bidding for Berinmadhoo in Haa Alifu Atoll will continue with the following amendments as per Clause 6 of ITB.
