The TAP Small Grants Scheme is established under the Tourism Adaptation Project (TAP). The project is aimed at increasing the adaptive capacity of the tourism sector in Maldives to respond to the impacts of climate change and invest in appropriate, no-regrets adaptation measures

The TAP grant scheme is founded on the belief that environmental problems can be addressed effectively, if people at the local level (communities and the tourism industry) work together and are involved in decision-making about sensible, no-regrets climate adaptation projects.

With appropriate funding, small projects at tourist facilities and at the grassroots level can make significant difference to sustainable livelihoods, the environment, and thus the continued success of Maldives tourism.

WHO CAN APPLY?

- Civil Society Organizations
- Registered Tourism businesses – Tourist resorts, Hotels, Guest Houses, Dive operators and Live aboard Vessels
- Scientific/Research Community

HOW IT WORKS?

Submit a project concept application form providing ideas and other useful information. The PMU will screen and if the concept proposal is deemed worthy, the party will then be asked to submit a detailed proposal.

MTAP Grant Evaluation Committee will select appropriate proposals for the Grant.

MTAP grants will be disbursed in installments based on implementation plan and satisfactory progress of project activities.

USEFUL INFO?

Duration of the proposed project should not be more than 12 months.

Projects should be implemented in a tourist facility or tourism associated community
