UNDP Maldives seeks the support of a national consultant for developing Training Materials and Conducting Training Sessions on the Addendum to the Building Code.

The primary objective of this consultancy is to develop training materials based on the addendum to the Maldives National Building Code and associated compliance documents developed under TAP. The training materials should focus on capturing all the new codes, recommendations and compliance mechanisms proposed. The consultancy also entails conducting of a workshop using the training materials developed.

Interested candidates must have at least an advanced university degree (Master's degree or equivalent) in architectural or civil engineering, the consultant must have at a minimum 5 years of experience in progressively senior levels in designing and supervising constructions in resorts, the consultant must have a thorough understanding of climate change and its implications on the Maldivian tourism sector.
